Chapter Reports

Attendance was taken and all Chapters that were present provided Chapter Reports and submitted them to the Vice Chief of Communications.

Newsletter Report

Zack Burgess, the Vice Chief of Communications said that the December newsletter is posted on the lodge Web site now. He said that as soon as he gets a few more Chapter articles that the February one will be released. He said that a few Chapters and Vice Chiefs have not yet submitted their articles.

Inductions - Gregory Geraldo

Membership & Finance Update - Ken Arndt

Ken reported that Mike is still out of town and that the online Lodge calendar is now up to date. He is reviewing the Ordeal Weekend registration and it should be going online this coming week.

Indian Affairs Ceremonies - Josh Gibson

Josh reported that he can use a Brotherhood Team for Scout Expo. Josh gave the following details for the Subcamp assignments:

AIA Update

Kim Wilkerson talked about the new American Indian Award that is available to all Arrowmen. He gave a brief overview of the eligibility criteria and showed where the forms are available on the bulletin board. He also said that he will send out emails informing the Lodge membership of Pow Wows that are being held in the area. Adviser Breakout Session

After the names are called, the Chapter Advisers and Chiefs will present the envelopes and special instructions to the candidates. Candidates who are absent can receive the packets in the mail. Lodge Advisers will be assisting at each subcamp.
- Ken said that the base does not permit fires nor digging.

Camp Promotions

Chris reminded everyone of the Camp Promotions training right after the CoC and that catered food would be served. All Advisers, Chapter Chiefs, and VC of Camping are encouraged to attend.

New Business

- Conner Shinn encouraged everyone to promote the Conclave and take advantage of the low price available until June 1. It's September 17 19.

Ken challenged the Chapters to start doing the Camp Promotions now and include the Vice Chief of Camp Promotions in the presentations to the Troops. He said that everyone should start signing up for all of the events now. The next CoC is April 17 and with a location to be determined later.
