


Thrive Goals for Inductions





2020 Unit Contact - By Chapter




Election Rate





ALL contingent members MUST log in to NOAERS and fix any issues with their account. Anyone over the age of 18 before and during the trip must have Youth Protection Training up to date.



Goals of the National Webinar

- Address the redefined role of the section, and explain how important each of you are to ensuring the success of our 266 lodges in the organization. It must be understood that our section leadership
 are the boots on the ground task force that exist to support, guide, and enable the lodges within their respective sections.
- Deliver new concepts focuting on the 3 key performance indicators. Unit Election Rate, Induction Rate, 9 Activation Rate.
- Assign and lay out a 3 year plan to ensure each lodge reaches the status of "high performing", meaning they have a 90% Unit Election Rate, 90% Induction Rate, and 50% Activation Rate
- Issue an organization wide call-to-action, including a commitment and a doclaration to elevate all 266 lodges to high performing status.

- A -HIGH PERFORMING LODGE - HAS A -**90% UNIT ELECTION RATE**, **90% INDUCTION RATE,** - AND -**50% ACTIVATION RATE.**
