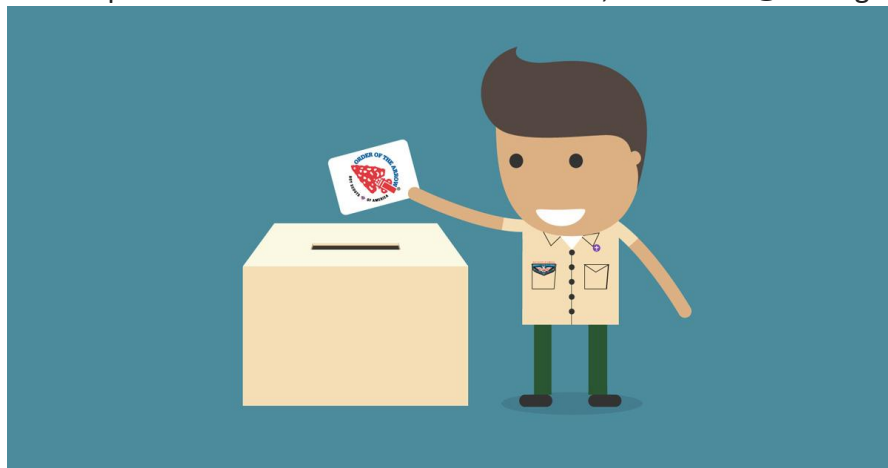

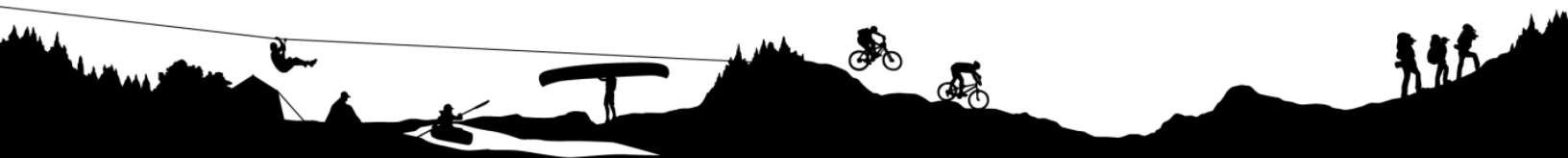


Chapter Spotlight
