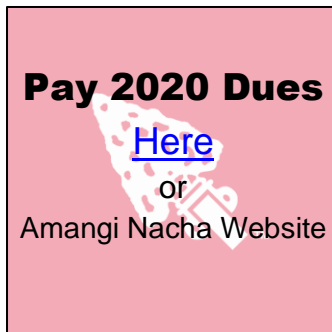
## Amangi Nacha & COVID-19
