Friendly Reminders

E. Removal of a Lodge Officer

a. Methods of Removal include:

- i. The Lodge Chief may remove any Lodge officer with the consent of both the Lodge Adviser and Lodge Staff Adviser. This is recommended for severe cases and sensitive issues.
- ii. The Lodge Executive Committee may remove any Lodge officer with a 2/3 vote.

b. Reasons for Removal may include, but not limited to, the following:

- i. Unexcused absences from two meetings.
- ii. Conduct unbecoming of an Arrowman repeatedly.
- iii. Breaking a major BSA, National Order of the Arrow, or Council rule.
