## Friendly Reminders

- E. Removal of a Lodge Officer
  - a Methods of Removal include:
    - The Lodge Chief may remove any Lodge officer with the consent of both the Lodge Adviser and Lodge Staff Adviser. This is recommended for severe cases and sensitive issues.
    - ii. The Lodge Executive Committee may remove any Lodge officer with a 2/3 vote.
  - b. Reasons for Removal may include, but not limited to, the following:
    - Unexcused absences from two meetings.
    - Conduct unbecoming of an Arrowman repeatedly.
    - iii. Breaking a major BSA, National Order of the Arrow, or Council rule.




