Scout Me In! What are we doing?

Scout Skills stations may include:

- Knot yard - Scouts Learn and Practice basic Knots and lashings
- Blade Safety - Scouts learn safe use and care of basic bladed tools (Knife, Hatchet, saw, and Axe)
- Fire building and safety
- First Aid (Tenderfoot - First class requirements)
- Outdoor Code, Leave No Trace, and Tread Lightly exposure
- Nature - Identify 10 Plants and 10 animals (or evidence of) in the camping area
- Orienteering/navigation skills - Maps, Compasses, and GPS exposure
- One hour of service to the park

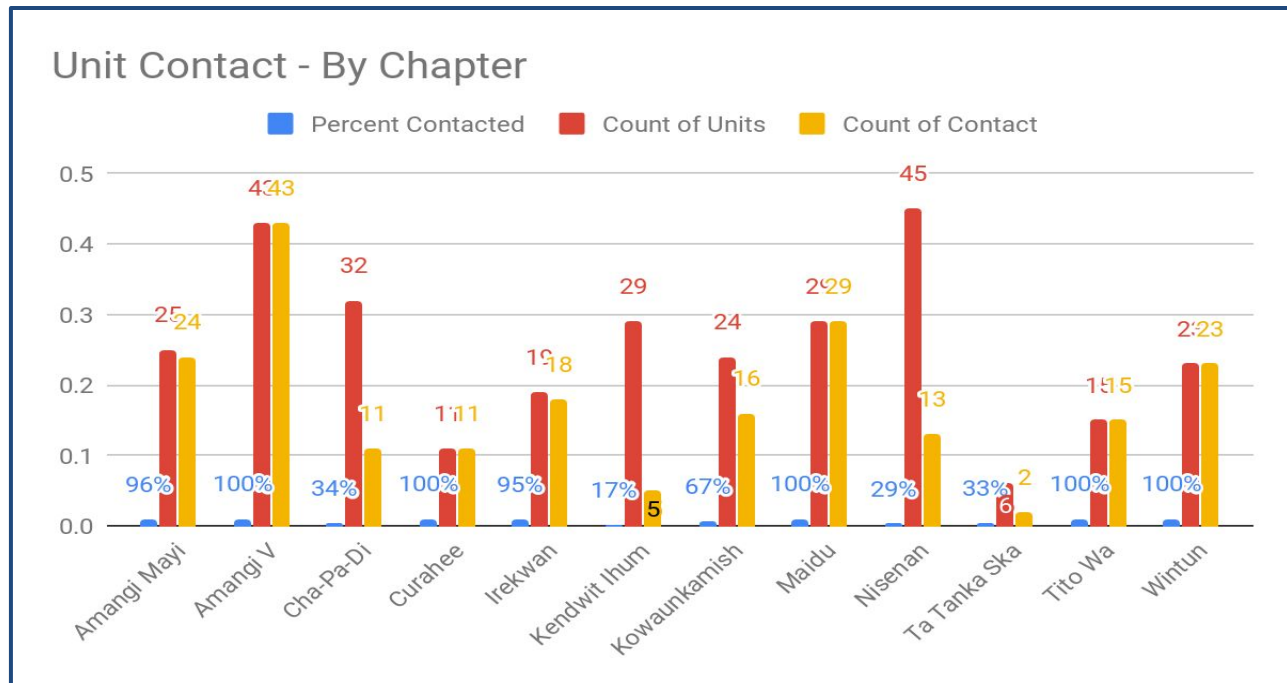

This chart reflects the percentage of units contacted by chapters.

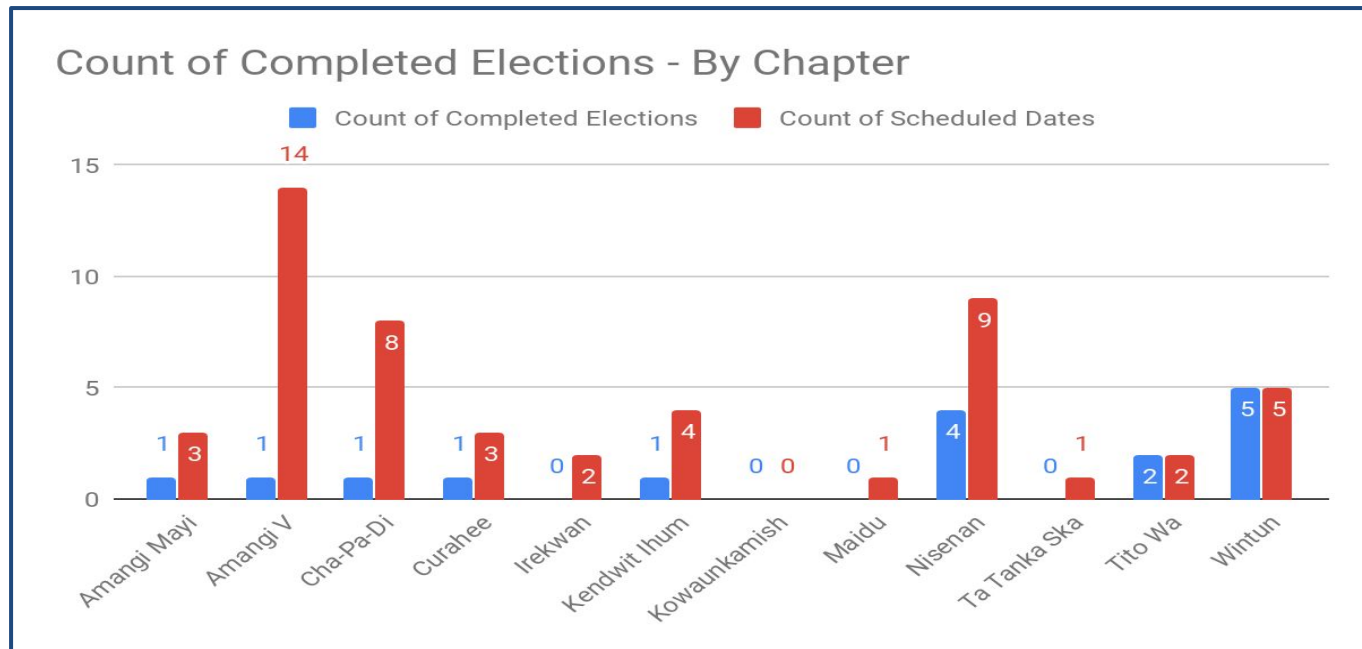

This chart reflects the percentage of elections completed

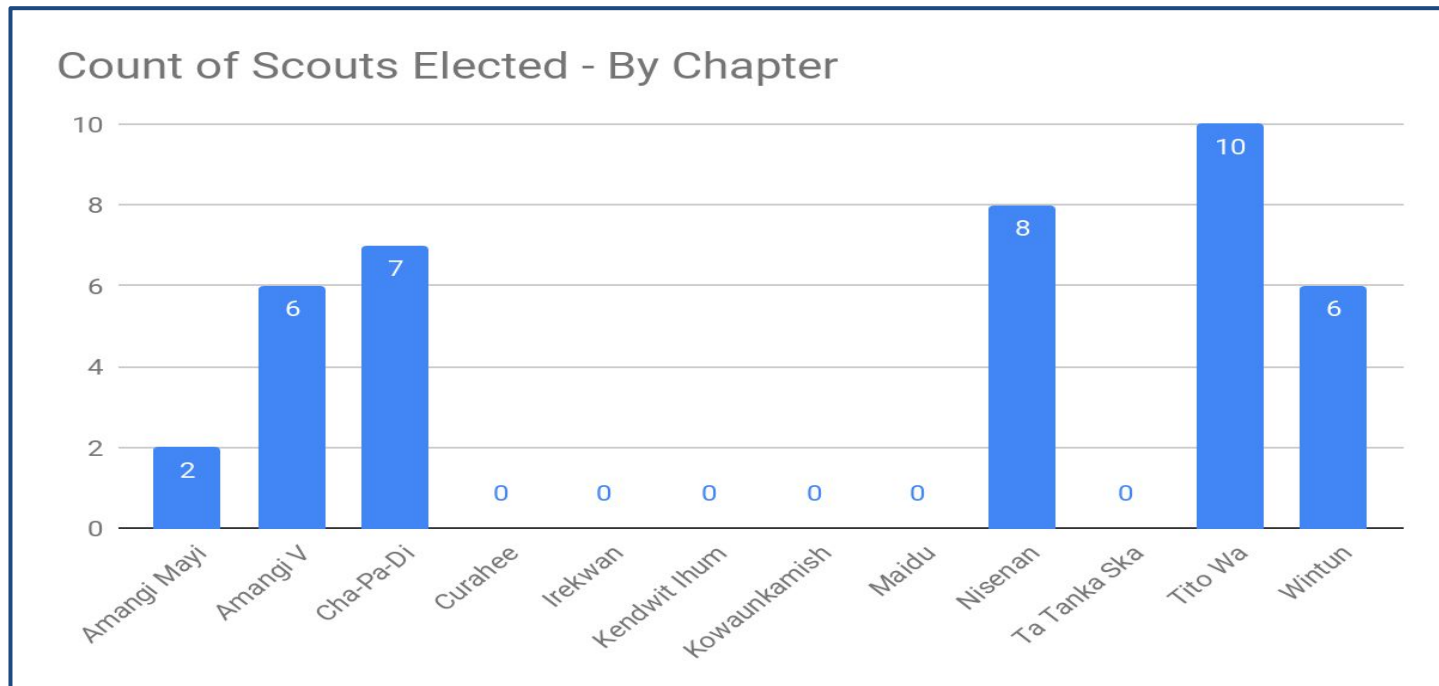
