



- Deliver new concepts focusing on the 3 key performance indicators. Unit Election Rate, Induction Rate, 9 Activation Rate.
- Assign and lay out a 5 year plan to ensure each lodge reaches the status of "high performing", meaning they have a 90% Unit Election Rate, 90% Induction Rate, and 50% Activation Rate.
- Issue an organization wide call-to-action, including a commitment and a disclaration to elevate all 266 lodges to high performing status.
