

## Parking Attendant

- In charge of greeting Conclave guests as they arrive, and directing cars into a pre-planned parking grid that will be provided prior to the event.
- Handing the parking placard to the driver of the vehicle
- Inform guests where check in will be, and answer any event questions they may ask.



## Host Lodge Registration Support Staff

- Tasked with assisting in Registration of Conclave Guests on site.
- Aid in distribution of Section Trading post pre-Order items as guests arrive and check-in.
- Provide any information to Conclave guests as they arrive.
- Additional tasks in registration as necessary.



## Concierge

- Assist with Check in & Registration of Conclave Guests on site.
- Aid in distribution of pre-Order items as guests arrive and check-in.
- Provide any information to Conclave guests as they arrive.
- Additional tasks in the registration area as necessary.



## Lodge Guides

- Be familiar with the camp layout.
- Tasked with familiarizing members of the different Lodges to their designated camping areas.
- Act as guides for the Lodge as they are settled in, and provide any necessary information about the camp to the guests.
- Post camp site inspection for lodge release.



## Amangi Nacha Trading Post

- Support Host Lodge Trading Post setup.
- Staff the Host Lodge Trading Post during the conclave (sell and market trading post items to Conclave guests, and help in the running of the trading post during hours).
- Support Host Lodge Trading Post closeout and cleanup



## Program Support Staff

- Place Igloos at Program areas (@ 2:30pm)
- Verify Igloos full each hour (3pm, 4pm, & 5pm)
- Remove Igloos for Program areas (@ 5:30pm)
- Collect program area trash.
- May help in program areas as needed depending on staffing.



#### Food Servers

- Arrive 10 minutes prior to meal time.
- Support bringing food to serving areas.
- Serve food.
- Ensure that your food serving area is clean during the duration of the meal.



## Dishwashing Crew

- Clean up of pots, pans, dishes and utensils following each meal shift.
- May include restocking of utensils on the line.



## Meal Clean Up Crew

- Clean up the lodge after the meal service is complete.
  - This includes:
    - Sweeping and mopping.
    - Cleaning tables and chairs.
    - Cleaning of serving area.



## Lodge Clean Up Crew

- Clean up of the Lodge following the dining shifts or other conclave activities in the lodge.
- Cleaning of Lodge main hall as well as the dining areas immediately outside of the Lodge.



#### Cracker Barrel Crew

- Help with set up of cracker barrel serving area
- Cleanup of pots, pans, dishes and utensils following Cracker Barrel.
- Clean up of the Lodge following the cracker barrel.



#### Bathroom Patrol

- What: Role includes cleanup, stocking, and inspection duties.
- Where: Responsible for cleanup of bathrooms listed: Wintun Bathroom, Trading Post Bathroom, Lodge Bathroom, Kiwanis Bathroom, Pirelli Bathroom, and Staff Bathrooms.



## Garbage Patrol

- Clean up of Garbage throughout the camp.
- Replace bags and transport them to the designated Trash collection areas.



#### Shooting Sports Set Up & Take Down Crew

- Assist in Setup of the Field Sports Ranges throughout Camp Lassen.
- Duties as assigned by the Rangemasters.
- Assist in the Take Down of the area



### Midway Setup & Take Down Crew

- Setup of games and activities on the midway.
- Instructions to be provided by the CVC of the Midway during Conclave.



#### Training Areas Setup & Take Down Crew

Setup & Take Down Training Areas, including tables and chairs.
