- NOAC stands for National Order of the Arrow Conference.
- Held every two years at a major university.
- The last one was the 2018 Order of the Arrow Conference, held at Indiana University. 2020 was canceled due to Covid.
- The next one takes place at University of Tennessee in 2022.
- 7,000-8,000 OA members from around the world gather in one location for some major fellowship and competitions.
- NOAC last's for six days with events and activities taking place the entire time.

- If you need money, there's plenty of ways to get it. Just start asking.


