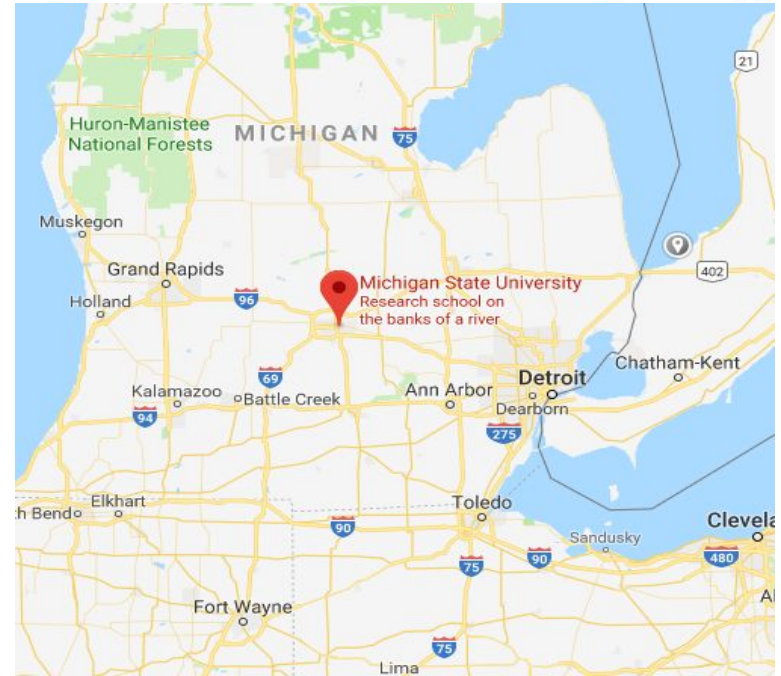

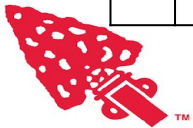
- Gold: Greater than (or =) 150 point

- Bronze: Greater than (or =) 50 points



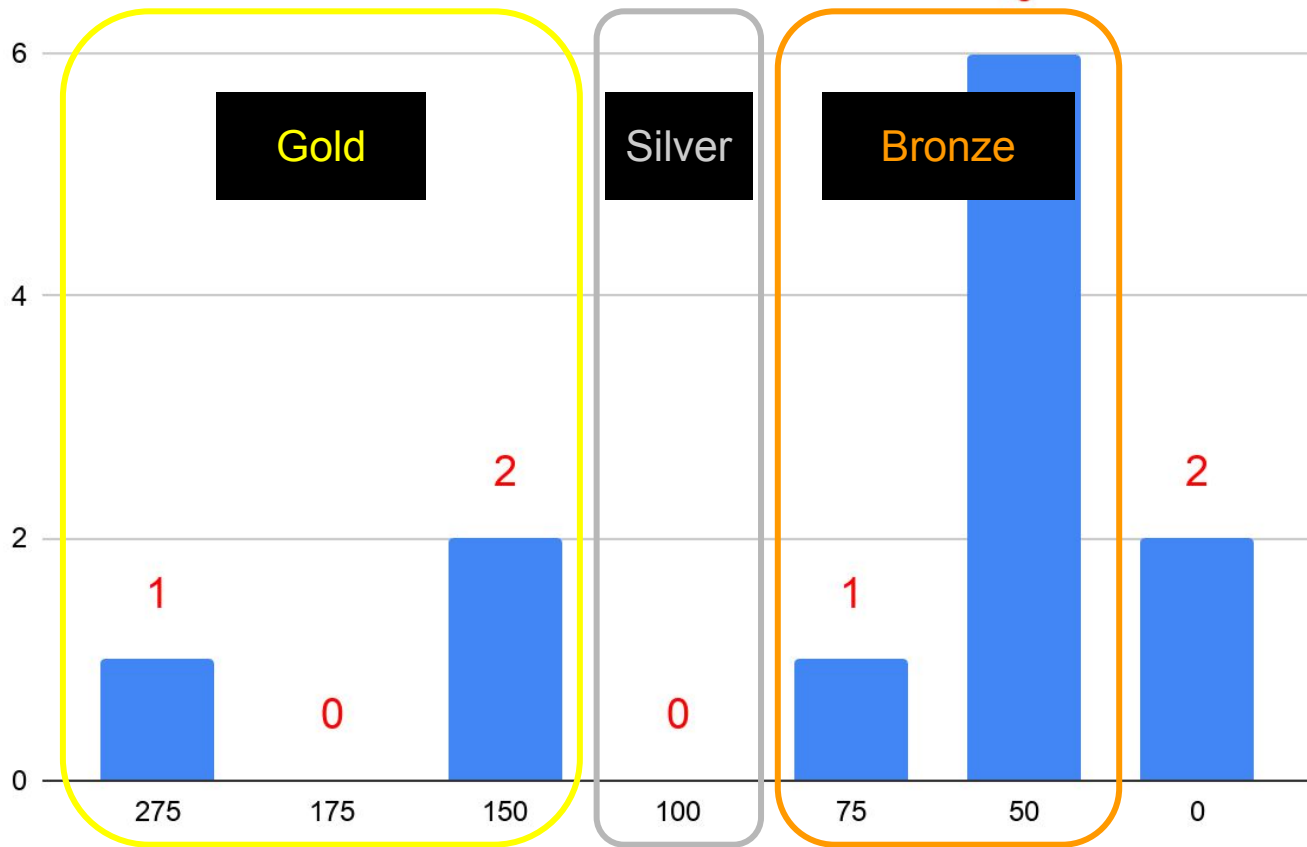
