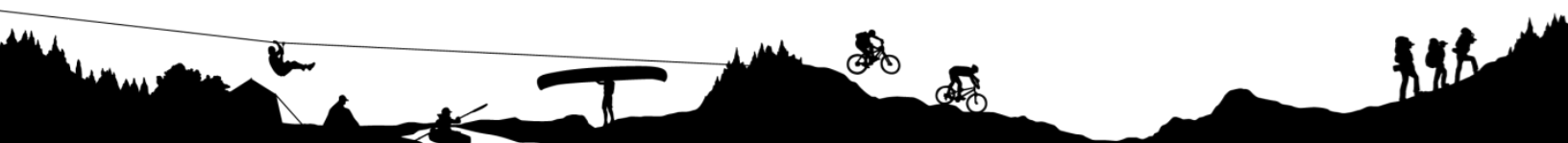

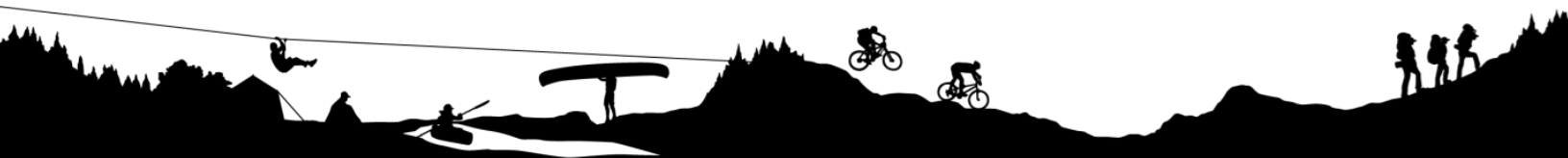
## Your Chapter Here
